1	Price Catalog under Appendix D, would include items not covered under the state Medi-Cal fee schedule?	Yes, the purpose of the vendor's Catalog of Prices is to provide pricing for items not included in the Medi-Cal Fee Schedule.
2	Being an LA County Registered vendor can they apply for this RSASQ	Yes, Vendors who meet the minimum qualification requirements, in Section 2.1, Sub-Section 2.1.1 Minimum Qualification Requirements - Option 1 or Sub-Section Minimum Qualification Requirements - Option 2 of the RSASQ, may apply submit a RSASQ response.
3	Alcam renders services in Glendale and Palmdale but currently do not have physical locations. Alcam does provide services to patients in this area by home visits. Is it acceptable to include these 2 locations in the RSASQ?	Please refer to Section 2.1, Sub-Section 2.1.1 Minimum Qualification Requirements - Option 1 or Sub-Section Minimum Qualification Requirements - Option 2 of the RSASQ for any area(s) you plan to submit a response for.
4	Does submission in electronic format mean via email?	Yes, submission "in electronic format" means "via email."
5	Where are the fillable Appendix forms located online for submission?	Yes, the fillable forms are attached to this Addendum and can be downloaded at your convenience.
6	Under Section 5.2, the DHS board of supervisors is the ultimate decision-maker, are there any other boards involved to make the final decision?	It is the County of Los Angeles Board of Supervisors (Board) and the Master Agreements resulting from this solicitation will be executed under the delegated authority from the Board.

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7	Is the vendor code the same as the County WebVen Number in Appendix A?	Yes, the "Vendor Code" in the County of Los Angeles' Vendor Self-Service System (VSS) is the same as the "WebVen Number" in Appendix A of the RSASQ.
8	For minimum Qualification Requirements - Option 1, is Appendices A-G the only forms that need to be submitted?	Yes, as stated in Section 2.1 Minimum Qualification Requirements, Sub-paragraph 2.1.1 of the RSASQ, the forms in Appendix A, B , C, D, & G must be completed and submitted eletrconically for Option 1.
9	Can I add additional Appendices to show all of our facility address and our Valued Added Services?	No, only the facilities listed in your completed Respondent's Facility Preference List, which is identified as Appendix G in Section 2.1 of the RSASQ, will be reviewed and considered.
10	What is the due date for the solicitation?	The initial due date for submitting RSASQ responses is revised to 3:00 p.m. Pacific Time on 8/27/2019 as identified in Sub-Section 2.3 Response Submission Instructions of the RSASQ. RSASQ responses received after the initial RSASQ Response Deadline may be considered at the convenience of the County. Once the County's needs are met, the RSASQ may be suspended.
11	Why do we only have 7 days notice to submit responses?	The RSASQ was issued to meet the service needs of the County and the initial due date for submitting RSASQ responses is revised to 3:00 p.m. Pacific Time on 8/27/2019 as identified in Sub-Section 2.3 Response Submission Instructions of the RSASQ. RSASQ responses received after the initial RSASQ Response Deadline may be considered at the convenience of the County. Once the needs of the County are met, the RSASQ may be suspended.
12	Want to make sure I submit the solicitation to the correct building?	RSASQ responses shall be submitted in electronic format only (which is otherwise described as submitted via email) per Sub-Section 2.3 Response Submission Instructions.
13	Do you know how different this solicitation is from the 2017 solicitation?	The RSASQ is a new solicitation and is unique and independent from other prosthetic and orthotic services solicitations issued by the County. Please read through the RSASQ for additional detail.
